Learning Objective

- To learn about “pitch” = high and low notes
- To understand the difference in their voice types– some feel more comfortable singing High and others Low
- To sing two independent parts at the same time

Introduction

- What is ‘pitch’? - Pitch is the difference in sound of the note – whether it is high or low. A string of *pitched notes* makes a ‘melody’.

- Students should stand (if able) and have plenty of space to stretch up high and crouch down low for physical actions whilst singing.
